For Field Workers

Praise God for the hundreds of Persians who received New Testaments and other Christian literature in their language during a community outreach in an immigrant community in the U.S. Pray they will read these materials and that the Lord will draw them to Him through His Word.

Ask for wisdom for a team in Southeast Asia seeking to reach two Buddhist people groups with the gospel.

Pray for believers in the Middle East participating in an eight-week ministry coaching program designed to encourage and equip them to serve more effectively within churches in a Muslim-majority area.

Praise God that the first Christian worship album in a Central Asian language, created by a group of Central Asian believers, was recently released! Pray that this music will encourage followers of Jesus and introduce many to the joy of knowing Him.

Ask the Lord to bring students whose hearts are soft toward the Holy Spirit to English classes run by Christar workers in a Kurdish community.



For Missions-Minded Believers

Pray for three givers whose children are expecting babies in the coming weeks. Pray for safe deliveries of these new grandchildren.

Lift up a couple that will soon depart to South Asia as they navigate several major transitions. Over the last few months, they have been adjusting to the routines of being new parents and will soon also be learning and acclimating to the cultural norms of their host community.

Pray for givers struggling with ongoing medical issues. Ask the Lord to surround each of them with supportive communities that can help in tangible ways and to give wisdom to their doctors about the next steps in care.

Praise God that one giver's grandson, who was born prematurely, is now thriving at home. Pray he continues to stay healthy and grow strong.

Lift up givers who have retired and are praying for clarity regarding the best ways they can serve the Lord and have a significant Kingdom impact in this new season of life.

For Partner Churches

Pray for the home churches of believers serving short term this summer, asking that they would send these workers well, stay connected with them while they are on the field and support them as they return.

Praise God for providing a sending church for a couple planning to return to Central Asia. Pray for wisdom for church leadership in coming alongside these workers as they seek to reach people with the gospel.

Lift up a small denomination of churches in the Northeast going through a transition in its mission leadership. Pray for the outgoing leader as he and his wife move to be closer to their adult children. Ask God for wisdom in selecting a new leader and for grace in transition.

Praise God that members of a church in Kansas are asking Him to work through them for His glory and looking for opportunities to serve. Pray for wisdom as they seek to be Kingdom-focused rather than just busy with activities.
