Join us in prayer for these needs from partners in the Great Commission.

For Field Workers

Praise God for two new believers in the Middle East who are zealously sharing their faith with others. Pray for wisdom for workers in discipling them.

Pray with workers in Canada that they'll see two Bible studies, one of Farsi-speakers and one of Arabic-speakers, established by the end of 2025.

Rejoice that 62 children in the Middle East prayed a prayer of salvation during a vacation Bible school program. Pray for wisdom in discipling them, that each boy and girl would grow strong in their faith.

Ask for wisdom for workers in South Asia as they seek to establish a sustainable business that opens opportunities for them to share the gospel in their community.

Workers in the United States are expecting over 100 students in their English class outreaches over this school year. Ask God to bring people from least-reached groups who are open to the gospel.

For Partner Churches

Lift up a North Carolina church that has set a goal of mobilizing five mid- or long-term workers each year. Ask God to move many people in this congregation to pursue cross-cultural ministry.

A Georgia congregation has commissioned their current missions pastor to plant a new church in another community. Pray this new fellowship will be established and grow, and ask for a smooth transfer to the new missions pastor.

Praise God that a Pennsylvania church is commissioning two members in October to serve among Muslims in Spain. Pray for wisdom in supporting this couple well as they prepare to head overseas.

Pray as a church in Indiana sends short-term teams to countries where believers frequently face opposition and persecution. Pray for safety and humility as these teams serve side by side with national believers.

Lift up many partner churches planning Christmas outreaches, asking God to guide them as they seek to share the good news of Jesus in their communities.

For Missions-Minded Believers

Pray for wisdom for a doctor as he visits Christar workers in Central Asia to explore opportunities to serve. Ask God to guide him and his church concerning his future ministry in an area where Christians often face severe persecution.

Praise God for raising up four Persian believers to minister on a servant leadership team at a Persian church in South America. Ask Him to work through them to help this fellowship grow in numbers and maturity.

Pray with a longtime partner of Christar who is fighting a debilitating disease, asking that he and his wife will keep their eyes on Christ and share Him with others amid their painful journey.

Rejoice that several new workers arrived in the Far East in September! Pray for grace for them as they adjust and begin language study.

Lift up givers whose children are not following Christ and have little or no communication with their parents. Pray for comfort and peace as they entrust these prodigals to God, and ask the Lord to work in their sons' and daughters' hearts, drawing each one to Him.

For the CMCUS*

Pray for the nine cross-cultural workers attending a RENEW retreat October 15-18. Ask that through this time of debriefing, reflection and connection, they will be refreshed and equipped for continued ministry in least-reached communities.

Continue to ask God to provide a new treasurer for the Christar Mobilization Center U.S.

Pray for good connections during Summit: Unity Unleashed, November 1-2. As we gather business leaders, church representatives, mission organization representatives and cross-cultural workers, pray we will collaborate well to form strategies that address challenges in the Great Commission.

Ask for good partnership as Christar, Switchboard and Pioneers work together to create resource kits that equip both churches and cross-cultural workers to engage virtual volunteers in global ministry.

Pray for wisdom in humbly and effectively serving churches that are seeking to be involved in global outreach in new ways.
