Inner Circle Requests

Lift up all those participating in pre-field trainings the first two weeks of June, asking God to give them endurance and to use these programs to equip them for effective ministry.

Pray for the safety of participants and teachers traveling to and from Dallas.

Lift up our TCK (third-culture kid) coordinator as she adapts to holding children's programs in a new setting during summer trainings. Pray that through this ministry, the children of workers heading overseas will be equipped with tools that help them navigate the challenges of living cross-culturally.

Praise God for the donors who are providing meals for participants in pre-field trainings, giving them much-needed fuel during two full weeks of sessions.

Pray for insight and discernment for the Christar U.S. Board as they meet on June 12.

Ask the Lord to guide the Executive Team as they consider properties in the Dallas area that could help Christar U.S. expand its impact among the least-reached in the area while continuing to serve workers ministering around the world.

Thank God for giving creativity and guidance to the Communications team as they worked on the new [annual report](#) and on "[Structure, Strategy, Support](#)," which explains Christar's role in the Great Commission and the ways individual believers and churches can be involved. Praise the Lord that both were released May 1, and ask that those who read them will be encouraged as they see how they play vital roles in establishing churches among the least-reached.

Praise God for the 23 people taking part in short-term trips this month! Pray that their love for the Lord and the least-reached will grow as a result of their time overseas, and that God would give each one discernment about next steps in ministry. And ask the Lord to lead some of them to serve long term with Christar!

Join us in prayer for these needs from partners in the Great Commission.

For Cross-Cultural Workers

Pray that those who interact with believers through a mobile medical clinic in the Middle East will see Christ reflected in His people and want to know Him personally.

Ask God to provide a pastor for a church of South Asian believers in Canada.

Praise God for young women in South Asia who have accepted Christ and are being trained for ministry in their communities at the CHL Women's Bible School. Pray they will be equipped well, and ask the Lord to work through them to draw many to Him.

Pray for continued wisdom and grace for workers serving in areas of ongoing conflict. Ask the Lord to protect them and enable them to reflect the peace and hope only found in Christ.

Praise God for bringing more people to picnic outreaches in a Kurdish community. Pray for wisdom for workers as they follow up with those who seem interested in spiritual things.

For Partner Churches

Ask God to guide members of a partner church in Kansas who are seeking more effective ways to communicate with and encourage the workers sent by this congregation.

Pray for a quick recovery for a denominational missions director who has undergone heart surgery.

Lift up the new lead pastor at a partner church in Indiana as he acclimates to his new responsibilities. Pray he will forge strong relationships, and ask the Lord to guide him as he seeks to shepherd this congregation with wisdom and godliness.

Pray for lasting impact following two church missions events in Pennsylvania and Illinois in early June. Ask that members of both congregations will become more involved in God's global work as a result.

Praise God for a church team that traveled to the Far East to encourage and serve workers during a conference. Ask the Lord to continue to use members of this team to give others in the church a greater heart for ministry among the least-reached.



For Missions-Minded Believers

Praise God for the 60 individuals who visited the Balkans over the spring to explore opportunities for ministry. Ask Him to guide each one regarding where and how He would have them serve.

Pray that a group of believers in Canada who are completing outreach training will be equipped to share the gospel with the many Sikhs in their community.

Ask the Lord to guide several believers serving short term in Southeast Asia this summer as they consider opportunities for long-term ministry in this region.

Praise God for a team of six, including five Deaf believers, who recently served short term among the Persian Deaf. Pray that those who encountered the gospel and experienced Christ's love through them will want to know Him personally.

Lift up two short-termers who recently returned from three months of service in Japan. Pray for opportunities for them to share about their experiences and encourage others to consider ministry in this country.

For the CMCUS*

Praise God for the new workers participating in pre-field training in June. Ask Him to guide them in all the details as they move forward on their journeys toward ministry in least-reached communities.

Lift up those raising support to serve on Christar short-term teams in the Far East, Southeast Asia and Central Asia this summer. Ask God to provide for their financial needs and prepare the hearts of people in the communities where they will serve.

Pray for those who read "Structure, Strategy, Support" (christar.org/SSS), a new publication that explains Christar's role in the Great Commission and how churches and individual believers partner with us in ministry. Ask that they will be encouraged by the ways God is using their roles for His glory.

Pray that the workers participating in a RENEW debriefing retreat in July will be refreshed, encouraged and equipped to continue serving in difficult places.
