Inner Circle Requests

Pray mobilizers will connect well with students and congregations during campus and church visits this month. Ask God to work in the hearts of many through these interactions, prompting them to seriously consider their role in His work around the world.

Pray for wisdom for Member Care staff as they prepare for the March RENEW debriefing retreat.

Ask God to bring several additional workers to participate in RENEW. Especially pray that a family experiencing health concerns will be able to come.

Ask the Lord to provide helpers for the third-culture kid program during RENEW. Pray that through this ministry, workers' children would connect well with one another and gain tools to help them navigate the challenges of living away from their passport countries.

Praise God for two churches that are working toward hosting [Christar Church Ministry Residencies](#). Ask God to bring participants who are eager to develop their ministry skills and to use their time at these churches to prepare them for effective service in the future.

Ask God to guide the Communications division in creating a new piece that introduces readers to ways they can participate in ministry among the least-reached through Christar. Pray that through it, He will prompt many people to get involved for the first time or in a new way.

Pray for endurance and skill for the Finance team as they prepare for our annual audit while continuing to adapt to new programs and procedures.

Ask for wisdom in preparing for the spring [EXPLORE Christar](#) program, a long weekend experience designed to help participants discern their next steps in fulfilling the Great Commission.

Ask the Lord to use Church Engagement reps as they share in workshops and other settings, seeking to help congregations become more actively involved in missions.

For Cross-Cultural Workers

Pray that a new business opened by workers in the Balkans will facilitate abundant ministry opportunities among a least-reached minority people group.

Join workers in North Africa in praying that they'll see two groups of believers meeting together for worship in their area by the end of 2026.

Praise God for believing Kurdish women who are regularly studying the Bible with a Christar worker. Pray they will grow in their faith and that the Lord will bring their husbands to salvation as well.

Pray for wisdom for Christar workers in Southeast Asia and their local partners as they explore opportunities to do community development work that opens doors for the gospel.

Lift up those who've heard about Jesus and interacted with His followers through a gospel choir outreach in a North African community in France. Pray each one will want to know Christ personally.

For Missions-Minded Believers

Pray for a team of believers from the Far East serving short term in Southeast Asia. Ask God to use this time to strengthen their faith and grow their hearts for least-reached people.

Praise God for a group of believers in the Middle East partnering to launch a new church plant. Pray for unity, and ask the Lord to work through their efforts to establish a thriving fellowship.

Ask the Lord to provide local pastors for several churches in South Asia.

Lift up several believers who recently took short-term trips to the Middle East and got glimpses of ministry in a Muslim community. As they share what they experienced, ask God to use them to help others learn what He's doing in this area of the world.

Pray for two young women spending three months in Japan as they explore opportunities for ministry. Ask God to guide them as they seek Him.

For Partner Churches

Praise God for two church leaders who recently traveled overseas to encourage workers and experience ministry there firsthand. As they share about their experience, ask the Lord to use them to encourage others to go as well.

Pray for wisdom for leaders at two Pennsylvania churches as they prepare for a weeklong missions conference and a missions event for teens. Ask God to use this time to give many in these congregations a heart for the nations.

Praise God for a group of 17 national church leaders from the Middle East who recently gathered to learn about biblical principles for serving others. Ask God to work through them in powerful ways as they apply what they learned.

Lift up a church in Georgia that's considering sending teams to serve cross-culturally. Ask the Lord to guide them in all of the details.

Praise God for a church that is sending a short-term team to encourage a worker in the Middle East. Pray this team will be a true blessing during their time on the field.

Pray that workers who attend the March RENEW debriefing retreat would be encouraged, equipped and refreshed for continued ministry in difficult places.

Ask God to work through the Mobilizing the Gospel podcast (christar.org/podcast) to help listeners better understand opportunities and challenges in ministry among the least-reached, and to equip and encourage them to be involved in the Great Commission.

Continue to pray for grace and skill for our Finance Team as they refine and implement new processes that will help them better serve our workers and donors.

Pray for the Church Engagement staff gathering for a retreat in March. Ask for wisdom as they form a strategic plan to serve churches well in the year to come.

Ask God to bring many who are considering cross-cultural ministry, as well as church leaders interested in sending well, to EXPLORE Christar March 27-29. Pray that He will work through this event to guide participants about their next steps.
