### Inner Circle Requests

Rejoice that God brought 15 people to attend [Explore](#) in September—above and beyond the number we prayed for! Pray for all who participated as they consider what they learned and take next steps.

Praise the Lord for a month full of opportunities to interact with students, campus leaders and church leaders! Pray that mobilizers will make good connections, and ask God to work through them in the lives of those considering how He could use them in the Great Commission.

Lift up the workers participating in the RENEW debriefing retreat. After hosting a large retreat in July, it will be nice to serve a smaller group. Pray for the member care staff as they seek to make this a meaningful and refreshing time, and lift up our TCK coordinator as she teaches and ministers to workers' children.

Pray for our director of personnel and member care coordinator as they travel to the international office in Spain to help with THRIVE, our conference for workers in their first term of cross-cultural ministry. Ask God to work through them as they teach a few sessions and are available for debriefing and consultation.

Ask for a smooth transition and flexible minds as we implement a new budgeting platform and tool. Pray that this change helps us steward our resources more efficiently.

Thank God for providing visas for several appointees, enabling them to go to the countries in which they're seeking to serve. Pray for grace and good "goodbyes" as they prepare to depart.

# Pray Together With

Join us in prayer for these needs from partners in the Great Commission.

## For Cross-Cultural Workers

Pray with a small team in the United Kingdom that God will raise up volunteers from local churches to partner with them in ministry to South Asian immigrants.

Lift up members of a minority people group in the Far East who've encountered stories from the Bible as workers have asked them for feedback on a translation project. Pray they will be transformed by God's Word.

Praise God for giving workers teaching college courses in least-reached communities opportunities to build relationships with both students and fellow faculty who don't know any other followers of Jesus. Pray for opportunities to clearly share the gospel.

Pray with workers in the Balkans that God will enable them to build relationships with more people from a Muslim minority group.

Ask for continual wisdom for workers discipling believers in the Middle East who risk severe persecution for following Jesus.

## For Partner Churches

Praise God for a church building a "home team" dedicated to caring for the workers this congregation has sent. Pray for wisdom as they seek to support their workers well.

Ask God to work through a missions conference at a church in Virginia to give members of the congregation a greater heart for the nations.

Praise God for several new discipleship groups in a small church in Minnesota, led by those who were discipled last year. Pray these new leaders will continue to be transformed by Christ as they humbly lead others into new life in Him.

Ask the Lord to provide the right person to serve as missions administrator at a church in Pennsylvania.

Rejoice in a church that recently sent its first worker in 15 years! Pray that this congregation will continue to grow in its involvement in global missions.

## For Missions-Minded Believers

Praise God for a team of eight believers traveling to Japan to help with an annual conference for workers in that country. Pray that through their service, workers will be encouraged and blessed.

Thank God for a group of several dozen believers in the Far East completing a training program to equip them to share the gospel and plant churches among the least-reached in their region. Ask Him to use this time to prepare them for fruitful ministry.

Pray for strength, protection and wisdom for a South Asian believer who travels to five communities around her city each week to do outreach, and ask the Lord to work through her.

Praise the Lord for over two dozen believers who helped a team in the United States host summer outreaches for refugee children and youth. Pray that the young people who participated would remember what they heard and for wisdom for workers in following up with them.

Lift up Southeast Asian believers who've been trained for church-planting ministry and are returning to their home island, seeking to reach it for Christ.

Praise God for everyone who participated in Explore in September and spent a long weekend seeking His guidance regarding their roles in the Great Commission! Pray for courage as they pursue their next steps.
