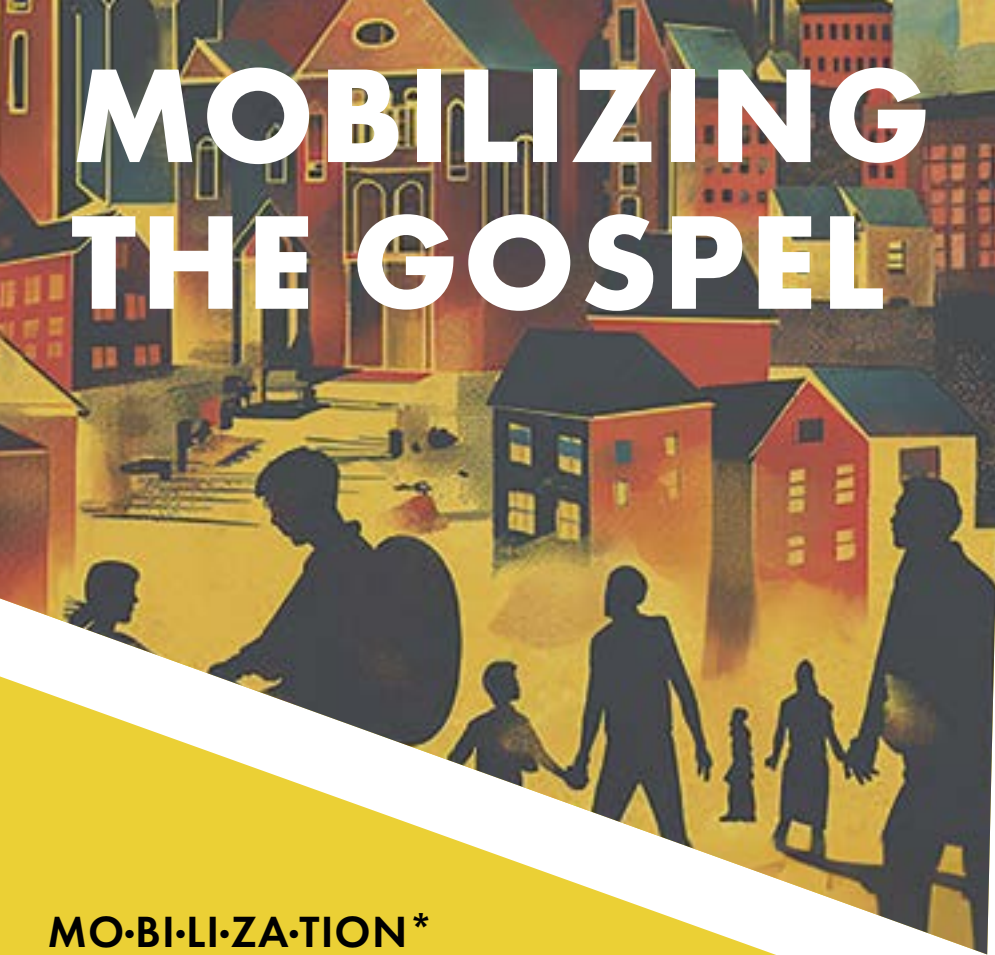


MOBILIZING THE GOSPEL

WHAT IS A MOBILIZATION CENTER?

The Great Commission is too great to do alone. More than 40% of the world's population is cut off from the good news of Jesus. That's 3.4 billion people living without the hope of Christ: the least-reached.[†]

No one organization, project or person can bring news of this hope to all of them. But together, the Church can. The Body of Christ was designed for this purpose, and we believe that every part has a role to play.

That's why we exist! The purpose of the Christar Mobilization Center U.S. (CMCUS) is to mobilize the Body of Christ, inviting each member to be involved in bringing the gospel to the least-reached. We connect people from throughout the Church to be part of what God is doing in least-reached communities. Christar serves Christ's Body as it participates in the Great Commission.

STEWARDED THE GREAT COMMISSION

We **help** churches send and care for their own who follow God's call to serve in least-reached communities.

We **connect** those who want to go with ways to use their unique giftings and skills in least-reached communities.

We **train and mentor** new cross-cultural workers to prepare them for effective ministry.

We **encourage and support** family members who release their loved ones for service among the least-reached.

We **come alongside** cross-cultural workers with care and resources that help them serve well and thrive in difficult places.

We **equip** believers to pray specifically and intentionally for the needs of cross-cultural workers and the least-reached.

We **partner** with God's people seeking opportunities to invest their many gifts and resources for eternal impact.

We **resource** missions-minded individuals to raise awareness of the least-reached within their spheres of influence.

We **invite** volunteers to use their professional skills remotely to help cross-cultural teams minister more effectively.



WHAT ROLES DO YOU HAVE IN THE GREAT COMMISSION?

Every believer is called to be part of bringing the gospel to the least-reached, but not everyone is called to be involved in the same ways.

SERVING CROSS-CULTURALLY

TRADITIONAL WORKERS

Cultivating

Full-time church planters live and serve in least-reached communities, proclaiming the gospel, discipling those who believe and gathering them together into reproducing fellowships.

MARKETPLACE WORKERS

Engaging

Missions-minded believers bring their professional skills and experience to the global marketplace, taking jobs and/or establishing businesses in places with little or no gospel witness.

SENDING

CHURCHES

Commissioning

Churches encourage their members to be involved in God's global work and commission some to serve as extensions of their ministry across the globe. They regularly support those they send, providing oversight and connection as well as prayer and financial backing.

FAMILIES

Releasing

Parents, grandparents and other loved ones sacrifice in-person connection for the sake of the gospel. They release family members who minister cross-culturally, encouraging them from afar. They also advocate for missions within their spheres of influence.

PARTNERING

PRAYER PARTNERS

Interceding

Believers pray for cross-cultural workers and the least-reached specifically and consistently. Through their dedicated service, they participate in faith for the work of the Great Commission.

FINANCIAL PARTNERS

Investing

Followers of Christ invest their resources to expand the global reach of the gospel. Their financial giving helps cross-cultural workers respond to needs and nurture opportunities for Kingdom impact.

Connecting
